

Tips for Keeping Your Pet Safe

- [Microchip](#) your pet.
- Always keep a collar on your pet and be sure a collar tag is securely attached.
- Take a look about your house and yard for ways for your pet to get out. Check for loose fencing or gaps, and keep an eye out for new 'escape routes'.
- Keep fence gates securely locked.
- Never allow your pets to roam freely in the neighborhood. Leash them at all times.
- Always transport a cat in a proper carrier.
- Take some good, up to date photos of your pet regularly.
- Take close-up shots that show details well. You want your pet to be unmistakable.
- Train your pet to associate a "Dog Whistle" with pleasant things. Blow the whistle each time just before you feed them. They will be more likely to respond to the whistle when they are lost if they associate the sound with feeding time.
- Make sure you can always be located when your pet is found.
